

# *Talk: Eskimo snapshots*

Alex Harris, director of the Center for Documentary Photography at Duke University in North Carolina will deliver a slide/lecture presentation for the public May 22 at 7 p.m. at the Anchorage Museum of History and Art on "Learning from Eskimo Snapshots."

During the lecture, he will discuss his experience living in and documenting Eskimo villages in

Alaska from 1973-1978.

Harris will be in Anchorage to conduct a workshop for the Alaska Photographic Center on May 23-24 also at the museum.

A documentary photographer, Harris photographed from 1971-1972 in rural North Carolina for a study of substandard living conditions, concentrating on the plight of migrant workers in eastern North Carolina.
