

NOTICE OF UTILITY APPLICATION

The ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION hereby gives notice that EYECOM, INCORPORATED has filed an application (Docket U-83-61) for certification of public convenience and necessity to furnish telecommunications (Cable Television) public utility service in and around the City of Galena and the Galena Air Force Base.

The Applicant's proposed tariff rates are, in part, as follows: initial residential installation charge \$50.00; residential and business basic 16-channel service at \$30.00 per month with two possible additional channels available at \$18.00 per month each.

More detailed information may be obtained from the Applicant whose address is 201 East 56th Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska, 99502. The complete filing is also available for inspection at the offices of the Alaska Public Utilities Commission, 420 L Street, Suite 100, Anchorage, Alaska 99501-1987.

Any interested person may file with the Commission by 4:30 p.m. September 12, 1983, a statement of views and specific reasons in favor of, or in opposition to, the granting of authority to the Applicant to operate as a cable television public utility, together with written confirmation that the same statement has also been mailed or delivered to the Applicant.

A competing application (Docket U-83-19) for certification of public convenience and necessity has been filed by Edgar M. Fears, d/b/a Yukon Cablevision, P.O. Box 116, Galena, Alaska 99741 in connection with which the Commission had established August 1, 1983, as the deadline for filing competing applications. Subsequently, Yukon Cablevision has withdrawn its application.
