

NOTICE OF UTILITIES APPLICATION

The ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION hereby gives Notice that The NORTH SLOPE BOROUGH PUBLIC UTILITIES (NSB), has filed an application to amend its certificate of public convenience and necessity Number 231 to furnish solid waste public utility service in and around the villages of Anaktuvuk Pass, Atkasuk (Meade River), Barrow, Kaktovik, Nuiqsut, Point Lay, Point Hope and Wainwright (DOCKET U-81-45).

The filing includes a new tariff that will be in force for the new service area, which is different from its present tariff covering service area 10. The rates shown in the new tariff are: no charge for normal refuse pick up service (both residential and commercial containerized service). Additionally, the labor charges for special service are:

Any interested person may file with the Commission by 4:00 p.m. September 10th, 1983, a statement of views and specific reasons in favor of, or in opposition to, the granting of the amendment to the Applicant's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Number 231, together with written confirmation that the same statement has also been delivered or mailed to the Applicant. In addition, any person wishing to file a competing application must file a notice of intent to do so within 30 days of this notice; i.e. by 4:00 p.m. September 10th, 1983, and the application itself must be filed within 90 days of the date of this notice; i.e., by 4:00 p.m. November 10th, 1983. Both a copy of the notice of intent and the application must be timely served on NORTH SLOPE BOROUGH PUBLIC UTILITIES, and written confirmation thereof filed with the Commission.
