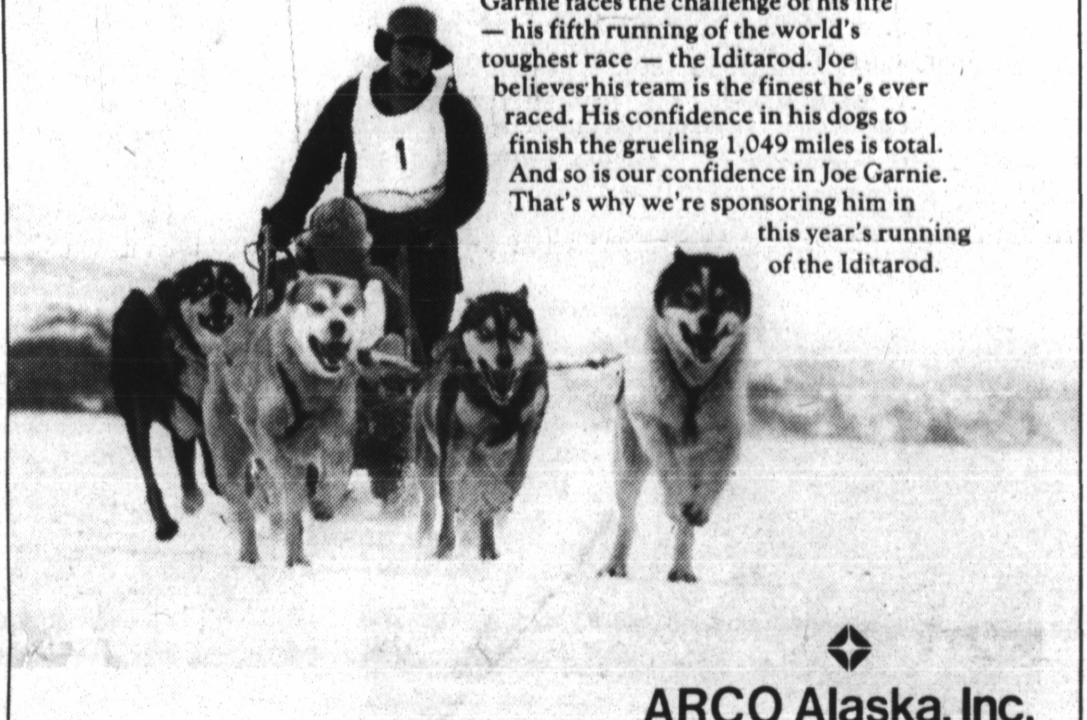


WHAT MAKES JOE GARNIE RUN?
