

The Tundra Times announces a photo contest devoted to pictures of life and events in Alaska's Native villages. To enter, send pictures of events taking place in your village. Pictures can be of anything, from a grandmother teaching her grandchildren to skin sew, a basketball team practicing, or people preparing for whaling or fish camp. Information on who took the picture, who is shown and what they are doing, should be included.

The Tundra Times will publish weekly winners in the paper, with information on the photographer, and the persons or events pictured. \$10 will be paid for each picture published.

Then, each month, a panel of judges will choose the best three pictures published in the previous month.

First-Place Winner Will Receive \$50. Second-Place Winner Will Receive \$25. Third-Place Winner Will Receive \$15.
