Tribal conflict resolutions

A two-day conference focusing on traditional methods of conflict resolution and peacemaking in traditional Indian communities and their roles in contemporary societies will be October 29 and 30 in Albuquerque.

Traditional tribal justice systems from the Northwest, Northeast, Southwest and Alaska will be examined.

The conference is open to all tribal leaders, tribal court judges and support personnel, tribal police, tribal and legal services attorneys, professionals trained in alternative dispute resolution (ADR) techniques and others in related professional fields.
