Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials and performing all work on Project S-0645(5), Chena Ridge Road, Paving and Bank Protection, described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, August 8, 1968, in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project consists of placing crushed aggregate base and hot bituminous surfacing of 13.623 miles of roadway and placing riprap at the Chena Townsite Rest Area. The project is located directly west of Fairbanks, Alaska.

Principal items of work consist of the following: 13,700 cubic yards of unclassified excavation; 70,900 tons of crushed aggregate base; 13,621 miles of reconditioning roadbed; 16,300 tons of hot bituminous pavement; 160 tons of liquid asphalt for prime coat; 2,037.5 linear feet of beam type guard rail; 4,075 linear feet of removal and reconstruction of guard rail; 8,100 tons of Class 1A riprap; and miscellaneous roadway items.

All work shall be completed by September 15, 1968.

Plans and specifications may be obtained by all who have a bona fide need for them for bidding purposes from the Commissioner of Highways. Plans may be examined at Department of Highways District Offices in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Juneau and Valdez.
