

# Horn to address Commonwealth

William P. Horn, Deputy Under Secretary, U.S. Department of Interior, will address a joint breakfast meeting of the Resource Development Council, Associated General Contractors of Alaska, the Alaska Oil and Gas Association, the Alaska Miners Association and Commonwealth North at 7 a.m., June 23. Horn will discuss Interior Department programs for implementing the Alaska D-2 lands legislation, oil and gas and mineral development proposals, and public lands policies in Alaska.

Horn was appointed Deputy Under Secretary by Interior Secretary James Watt in March, with special responsibilities for coordinating policy initiatives relating to Alaska. Horn is especially well-versed on Alaska lands and resource issues having served as the minority staff consultant to the U.S. House of Representatives Interior and Insular Affairs Committee during committee debate and consideration of the Alaska Lands Bill.
