Pursuant to 19 AAC 90.140(c) and 91.0, notice is hereby given that the undersigned has found the "Petition for Recognition" submitted by the Chignik Village Council to be acceptable under applicable sections of the Municipal Trust Lands Reversion. There having been no adverse written comments received nor any other petition filed pursuant to Notices of Publication dated April 20 and 22, 1981, and Notice of Posting dated April 27, 1981, the undersigned hereby states her intent to recognize the Chignik Village Council as the appropriate entity, under AS 44.47, 150 and 19 AAC 90.010 et seq., to represent the residents of Chignik in decisions affecting municipal trust land for Alaska. This recognition will take effect, without further notice, 30 days following the date this notice is posted or 30 days following the last date of publication, whichever is later, unless adverse written comments are received within that period, and will remain in effect thereafter unless and until reached in accordance with 19 AAC 90.150.
