

Fish and game names Zahn

The Alaska Boards of Fisheries and Game have chosen Milstead C. Zahn, of Juneau, as their new Executive Director. As head of the Department's Division of Fish and Game Boards, Zahn replaces Gregory F. Cook, who resigned from the post March 23.

Zahn, 50, is a 26-year resident of Alaska. He has spent the last 25 years with various federal fish and wildlife programs ranging from offshore foreign fisheries management to working with rural subsistence users. Since 1975 he has been in charge of a marine mammals program for the Enforcement Branch of the National Marine Fisheries Service.

As Executive Director, Zahn will be responsible for all operations of the Boards, which are the decision-making bodies responsible for promulgating fish and game regulations in Alaska.
