

Alaska Native Reporters and Producers Workshop, Oct. 23-25

Native staff members at Alaska's public radio stations will gather in Anchorage this month for an Alaska Native Producers and Reporters Workshop. The workshop will provide training in Radio Production Technique and Broadcast Journalism. It also represents the first opportunity for Native radio producers in Alaska to focus on development of programming for Native audiences and to discuss ways to handle special problems related to Native employment in public broadcasting. The Alaska Native

Producers and Reporters Workshop takes place on October 23-25.

Workshop leaders include Gary Fife of Migizi Communications in Minneapolis; San Francisco-based production engineer Kim Aubry; documentary producer Anita Parlow of Washington, D.C.; and Reba Whiteshirt of the Native American Public Broadcasting Consortium (NAPBC) in Lincoln, Nebraska.

The training is sponsored by KBRW-AM in Barrow and KOTZ-AM in Kotzebue, and is funded primarily by the NAPBC.
