

Alaskan Choice Television gets first customer

With the equipment he is receiving, Harris and other customers to follow can take advantage of a new television programming service soon to be available to residents in Anchorage and Fairbanks areas. Programming is now coming on-line and expected to be fully operational this month.

Alaskan Choice Television viewers will have the opportunity to receive premium television programming through UHF antennas. At this time various channels are being broadcast "in the clear" and free of charge to enable viewers the ability to see if the signal is available in their area.

"If you can receive our signal via your UHF antenna, you can take advantage of this service," said Quinto.

Alaskan Choice is offering 16 channels of programming in Anchorage and 25 in Fairbanks. Rates for the basic package in the Anchorage area, which includes Disney, will be only \$29.95. The basic package rate for Fairbanks is only \$39.95.
