Program Information:

• The Program was created to increase home ownership and affordable housing within the Anchorage area.

• It is designed for Alaska Native and American Indians who are very low to low-

income.

• It provides HOME partnership loans to eligible applicants as they finance a new home.

Who is eligible?

• First time homebuyers (someone who has not owned a home in the past 3 years).

• Applicants who have an annual income at

or below HOME Program income limits.

 Applicants who can provide a potion of the initial cash down payment for the house and other related closing costs.

 Applicants who are willing to comply with program requirements.

Families or individuals.

The funding for Home loans is Limited and will be expended on a "first come, first served basis". The Cook Inlet HOME Partnership Program is sponsored by Cook Inlet Tribal Council (CITC) and administered by Cook Inlet Housing Authority (CIHA).
