## Koyukon **Corporation Meets**

The fall regional board meeting of the Koyukon Development Corporation was held October 6-7 in Galena, with nine

villages represented.

A resolution was adopted that Housing and Urban Development (HUD) refrain from setting flood plain requirements which make it impossible or unnecessarily difficult to finance and

relocate new housing.

Other resolutions were adopted by the Board as follows: Requesting that the regional director keep their villages informed of state and federal pro-ams available, That more training programs and information be given so that village people may acquire secretarial, accounting and managerial skill. Also, that because few Natives can afford expensive homes which are being planned by the Alaska Federation of Natives, that the AFN should think in terms of each village in an area, rather than considering the area as a whole, and the AFN should not try to sell housing that will be beyond the means of the recipients, financially, or otherwise
