

Theme for 1993 AFN meet is 'A Shared Responsibility'

The 1993 Alaska Federation of Natives Convention will be held October 14, 15, 16, 1993 at the Egan Convention Center in Anchorage. The theme for this year's convention is "Sharing our Future, Commitment, and Responsibility." The agenda will include panels on economic development, leadership, cooperation, and protection of culture.

The largest meeting of its kind in Alaska, the AFN Convention brings together more than 3,000 delegates and guests from across the state. The convention serves as a forum for the critical issues of the day. AFN delegates meet to set direction for AFN in the coming year, examine long term goals, vote on resolutions and elect representatives.

A number of activities are held in conjunction with the convention during the week, including the Youth Conference and Elders Conference, October 11-13.
