

Notice of Utility Tariff Filing

The ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION hereby gives notice that GCI COMMUNICATION CORP. (GCICC), an interexchange telecommunications utility, has proposed a tariff revision (TA23-419) to add a new feature, 1-800-Collect, to its message telephone rate schedule.

GCICC's proposed tariff language provides the following description of 1-800-Collect service:

This service allows calls to be placed by dialing a [GCICC] Company provided access number which permits the caller to place a call with the assistance of an operator.

GCICC proposes special rates for operator-dialed collect and operator-dialed person-to-person collect calls placed using the 1-800-Collect service. Examples of proposed per minute charges for operator-dialed collect and operator-dialed person-to-person collect calls placed using the 1-800-Collect service follow:

GCICC also proposes to apply the following service charges to operator-dialed collect calls and operator-dialed person-to-person collect calls placed using the 1-800-Collect service:

Operator-Dialed Collect\$1.47 per call

Operator-Dialed Person-to-Person Collect\$2.85 per call

If the Commission finds that the rates proposed by GCICC are not just and reasonable, the Commission may approve a rate or classification which varies from those proposed.

Any interested person may file a statement of views favoring or opposing this tariff filing with the Alaska Public Utilities Commission. If you are a person with a disability who may need a special accommodation, auxiliary aid, or service or alternative communication format in order to comment on the proposed tariff revision, please contact Pat Oldenburg at 263-2107 by 4:30 p.m., June 18, 1993, to make any necessary arrangements.

To assure Commission consideration of comments or petitions prior to a final decision on this matter, those comments or petitions must be filed by June 24, 1993. Any statement filed with the Commission in determining the appropriate action to be taken, those comments will not serve to make the person a party to the proceeding. Any person wishing to become a party must file a petition to intervene in accordance with 3AAC 48.110 of the Alaska Administrative Code. DATED at Anchorage, Alaska, this 9th day of June, 1993.

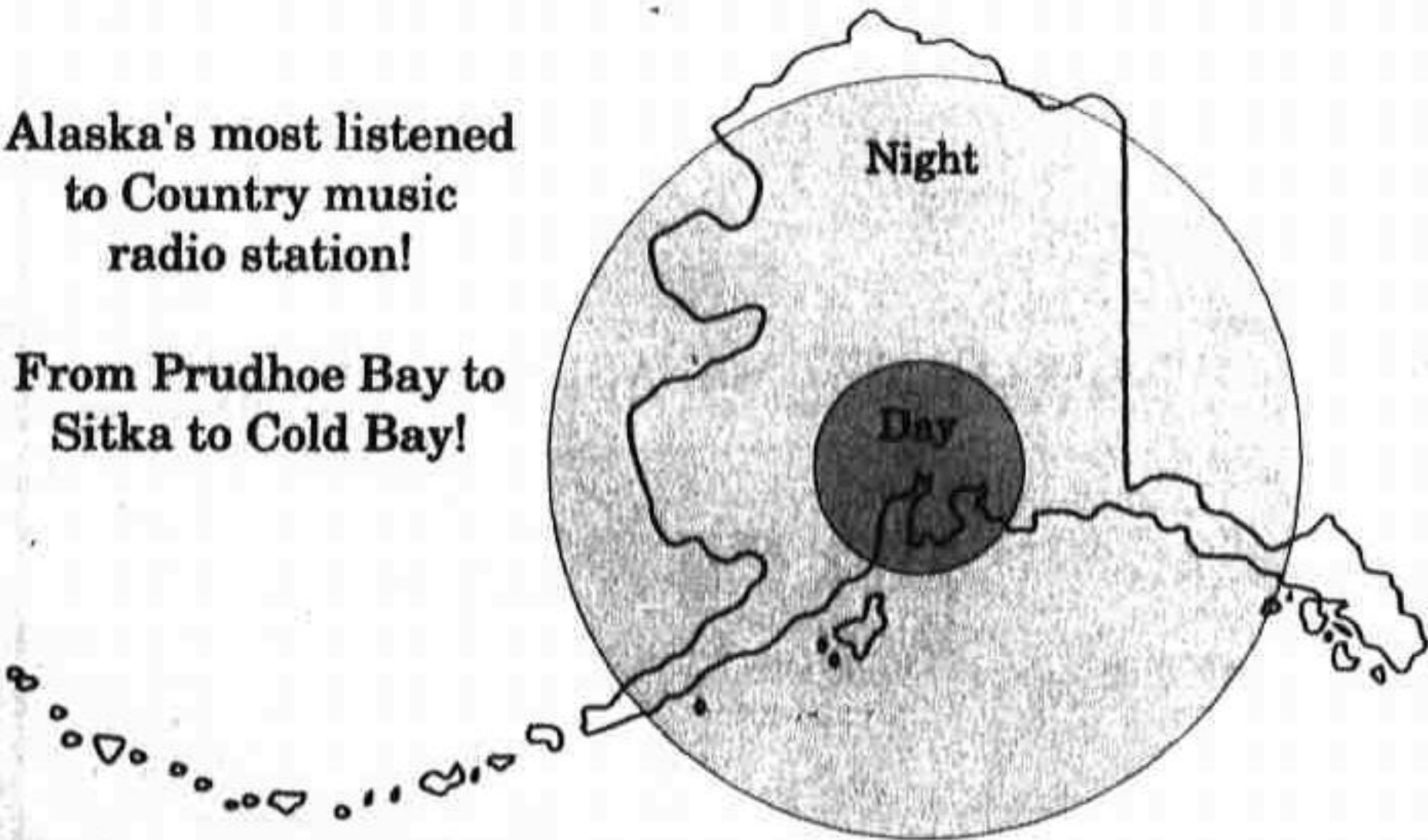
