

NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the Alaska Election Code, as amended, and in conformity therewith, a General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 4, 1980, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M.:

- (1) For the purpose of electing:

A UNITED STATES SENATOR
A UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE
TEN (10) STATE SENATORS

98, 99, 114, 118, and 121
RETAINING ONE (1) SUPREME COURT JUSTICE
RETAINING SUPERIOR COURT JUDGES
RETAINING DISTRICT COURT JUDGES
- (3) and to Vote on the following ballot propositions:
LEGISLATIVE ANNULMENT OF REGULATIONS
DISQUALIFICATION OF LEGISLATORS
INTERIM AND SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES
APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION OF MEMBERS
OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS
INITIATIVE NO. 79-02, ALASKA GENERAL STOCK
OWNERSHIP CORPORATION (AGSOC)

Locations of polling places and precinct boundaries will be posted in all election districts. Any voter, whose name does not appear on the list of registered voters for the precinct, may vote a questioned ballot at the precinct. The ballot of a registered voter who votes in this manner in a precinct in which he is not registered but in a district in which he is registered will be counted in full. The ballot of a registered voter who votes in this manner in both a precinct and district in which he is not registered will be counted only for statewide offices and propositions.
