

Port Lions to receive harbor

A small boat harbor is to be built at Port Lions on Kodiak Island.

The Army Corps of Engineers is inviting bids for a contract to develop a 5.85 acre mooring basin at the Settler Cove site. The project will involve quarrying some 67,000 cubic yards of

rock to construct two breakwaters—a main breakwater 600 feet long and a stub breakwater 170 feet long.

Both large and small businesses may compete for the contract which is expected to cost between one and five million dollars. Bids will be opened November 6 at the Corps' Alaska District Office on Elmendorf Air Force Base, and the successful bidder will have until October 31, 1982 to complete the work.
