

# Smithsonian Museum Workshop Slated

From Wednesday through Friday, October 22-24, the North American Indian Museums Association and the Smithsonian Institution will conduct a regional training workshop at the Anchorage Historical and Fine Arts Museum, the purpose of which is to train Native Americans in museum methods and techniques, to familiarize them with local and national museum resources, and to provide an opportunity to discuss mutual concerns. The workshop will feature sessions on exhibit design, label writing, the exhibition of documents, the conservation of objects, proposal writing and museum resources.

This training workshop is aimed at a limited type of participation to those really serious persons interested in museum management and display, and related subjects.

Organizations taking part will be the North American Indian Museums Association, Smithsonian Institution, Anchorage Historical and Fine Arts Museum, Alaska Humanities Forum, Alaska State Museum, Alaska State Council on the Arts, and the Institute of Alaskan Native Arts. The workshop is open by invitation only.
