**MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE
POLICE OFFICER STANDARDS CONNECTION**

You may have recently attempted to apply for Police Officer with the Municipality of Anchorage during its current recruiting period (ending July 6th), but did not because you could not meet the drug-use related standards as listed on the Alaska Police Standards Council (APSC) Questionnaire. Please know that those standards have now been reduced somewhat, primarily to eliminate disqualification due to drug use before age 21, and to relax the marijuana-use standard. If you did not apply because you did not qualify under the original standards, you are encouraged to review the new standards and submit an application if you can now pass.
