PUBLIC MEETING AND PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Arctic District Office of the Bureau of Land Management will hold a public meeting to take general comments on the Utility Corridor Draft Resource Management Plan and Environmental Impact Statement. Immediately following the public meeting will be a hearing to receive comments on the issue of subsistence within the Utility Corridor planning area as required by Title VIII of the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act (ANILCA). Following that will be a hearing to receive comments on the preliminary wilderness recommendations in the Central Arctic Management Area (CAMA). Section 1001 of ANILCA directs the Secretary of the Interior to review CAMA lands for wilderness designation. The draft plan includes these recommendations as a supplement.

These meetings and hearings will be held at the North Slope Borough Assembly chambers in Barrow on Tuesday, September 29, 1987, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The public is invited to attend and offer comments.
