

Boards of fish, game prepare for separate winter meetings

The Alaska Board of Fisheries and the Board of Game have issued calls for proposals for this winter's meetings of the separate boards.

The Board of Fisheries will accept proposals for any finfish regulations affecting fisheries in Kodiak, Chignik, the Alaska Peninsula, Bristol Bay, the Arctic-Yukon-Kuskokwim area, the Bering Sea and statewide general finfish provisions.

The Board of Game is accepting proposed changes to trapping regulations.

In addition, the board will consider proposals for changes in hunting regulations on permits for access to the McNeil River state game sanctuary; the issue of drawing permits; discretionary permit hunt conditions and procedures, the lawful methods of taking fur animals; and the salvage of game meat, fur and hides.

Board of Fisheries proposals must be received no later than 4:30 p.m., Sept. 11.

Board of Game proposals must be received by 4:30 p.m., Friday.
