

NSB to again sponsor computer graphics meeting

The North Slope Borough once again will sponsor a conference on computer graphics and geoprocessing. The conference will be held at the Anchorage Westward Hotel from Sept. 24 to 26.

More than 250 participants and speakers from as far away as Mexico, Canada and Harvard University, are expected to attend.

Borough Mayor Jacob Adams said he decided to sponsor the conference again because of the success of the first conference held in August of 1980.

The conference will focus on the application of computer graphics in the fields of resource planning, education, health, policy development and planning, and business management.

Faye Alexiev, president of Research Design Productions who organized the 1980 conference is in charge of the 1981 meeting.

She said that the conference will be geared to decision makers users and potential users with little or no background in computer technology. Several seminars will be conducted for persons with experience in the field.
