NOTICE OF UTILITY TARIFF FILING

The ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION hereby gives notice that GCIC COMMUNICATION CORP. (GCICC), an interexchange telecommunications utility, has proposed a tariff revision (TA22-419). GCICC states that the purposes of this filing are to modify the application of Customer or Operator-Dialed Company Calling Card rates for 800-950 Access and to increase the customer discount for Prime Option Instate.

GCICC proposes the following modifications to the Customer- or Operator-Dialed Company Calling Card rates section.

- GCICC deletes the sentence: "Rates vary based on how the call accesses the Company's network."
- GCICC eliminates the separate rate provision for Customer Dialed 1-800 Access and applies the current Day period rates for Customer Dialed 950 Access to Customer Dialed 800-950 Access.

GCICC also proposes to revise the Prime Option In-State schedule to increase the volume discount for billed amounts of \$50.00 to \$100.00. The current discount is 5%. GCICC proposes a discount of 7%.

If the Commission finds that the rates proposed by GCICC are not just and reasonable, the Commission may approve a rate or classification which varies from that proposed.
