

Candidate Pamphlet Available

Lt. Gov. H.A. "Red" Boucher announced recently that cassette tapes of the state's first official Election Candidate Pamphlet are now available in all public libraries and state Election Offices throughout the state of Alaska.

These cassettes are designed for use by the blind or individuals who have difficulty reading regular printed materials.

Recorded on the tapes is information contained in the Election Candidate Pamphlet which was recently mailed to all registered voters in the state.

The pages of the statewide candidates (Governor, Lieutenant Governor, U.S. Senator, U.S. Representative) are recorded on the cassette tapes. Also included

is information on the general obligation bonds to be voted on in the Nov. 5 general election.

These tapes were prepared by the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, in cooperation with the Alaska State Library. They are available to any individual or group from all public libraries or from the State Election Offices located in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Juneau and Nome.
