Alaska National Guard Accepting Registrants

The Alaska National Guard is now accepting enlistments by registrants who have received notice of induction. The change in procedures was announced earlier this month by Selective Service officials in Washington.

Prior to July 1, men who had

received notice of induction from their local selective service boards were ineligible for enlistment in the Army or Air National Guard.

The enlistment in the Guard must be completed at least ten days prior to the date of induction.

Full details on the program are available from Army and Air National Guard recruiters throughout the State, and from local selective service offices.
