

Special Land Claims Issue Due--

AFN, TT Special Edition May Number 100,000 Copies

TUNDRA TIMES, in conjunction with the Alaska Federation of Natives will publish a special land claims issue next month as a final report to the native people before a land claims bill goes to President Nixon.

"This issue is a necessity to inform the native people," announced AFN executive director Harry Carter about the special issue which may provide as many as 100,000 copies. Projected publication date for the commemorative issue is Decem-

ber 8.

The special publication will include the full text of the House-Senate Conference Committee report on the land claims bill plus the AFN counsel's analysis of the provisions.

It will also report to the native people on the special AFN Convention to be held in Anchorage immediately after the Conference Committee finishes its work.

Filled with pictures, native

history and human interest the 1971 Special Land Claims Report promises to quickly become a collectors item.

Copies will be distributed to Alaskan native villages courtesy of the Alaskan Federation of Natives and will be available to the public for \$1 each.

Special reports from regional organizations, AFN programs, and other matters of vital interest to Alaskans will make the special issue a must reading.
