Fairbanks Man Starts Fund For Aid of Richard Mueller

A Fairbanks man has donated \$10 for the legal assistance of former State Land and Lease Sales Manager, Richard Mueller.

As reported in previous issues of this paper, Mueller claims he was wrongfully fired by the state when he brought to light that the Indians of Tanacross had a historic claim on land proposed to be sold by the state.

The land around George Lake was to be sold as wilderness estates through promotion at the New York World's Fair.

Goro Shiotsigu, of Japanese ancestry, was so much impressed with Mueller's plight that he has donated \$10 to a legal aid fund and asked that natives of Alaska contribute too.

"I will match \$1 for every \$100 of native donations," Shiotsigu says.

Mueller, through an attorney, has filed with the Superior Court in

Fairbanks for a petition of review of a decision by the State Personnel Board.
