Aliens in Alaska

The Subcomnittee on Immigration and Naturalization of the Senate Judiciary Committee recently published a report by the Immigration and Naturalization Service listing all allens in the United States who reported in January of this year under requirements of the immigration and nationality act.

The report lists 2,822 allens in
