

U OF A REGISTRATION

FAIRBANKS—A special, simplified method of “express” registration for courses at the University of Alaska, Fairbanks, is available for persons 21 years of age or older taking only one or two courses and not working toward a degree.

Those qualifying for this special registration need not file transcripts of previous coursework, and do not have to apply for admission, but they are limited to no more than six credits per semester.

Registration for the university's spring semester will be

held on Monday and Tuesday, Jan. 14 and 15, 1974. Specific times for the special "express" registration will be announced at a later date.

Regular students working toward degrees will register by appointment. These degree candidates (both graduate and undergraduate, full-time and part-time) are not eligible for the "express" registration; they must complete regular registration. Also, any degree candidate returning to the university after an absence of a semester or more must file an application for re-admission in order to reactivate his file.
