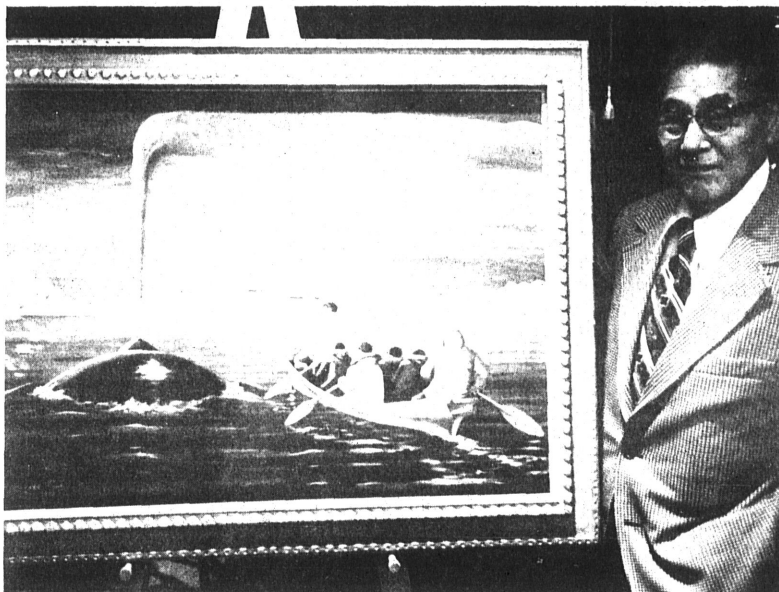


ANNIVERSARY BANQUET OF TUNDRA TIMES
