

Committee Head Promises Action On Pribilof Bill

WASHINGTON—Senator E. L. (Bob) Bartlett reported that Rep. John D. Dingell (D.-Mich.), chairman of the House Subcommittee on Fisheries and Wildlife Conservation, has promised prompt committee action on Bartlett's bill giving home rule to residents of the Pribilof Islands.

Dingell's subcommittee must approve the measure before it can be brought to vote in the House.

In a letter to the Michigan Representative, Senator
