Bethel Bulkhead To Extend 400 Ft.

BETHEL. (Special)— The

city council of Bethel has approved the work and material cost of extending the seawall about 400 more feet downriver. The project is expected to be started sometime this month.

The City has already constructed the building of more than 2,000 feet of seawall through local funds and from financial help from the State. Recently, an engineer from the Corps of Engineers predicted the wall would last five or six years without

appreciable damage.

The Corps is presently reopening its study of the project to see if it can be made
a permanent structure.

Charles Degnan, local Neighborhood Youth Corps director, has indicated that his agency may be able to supply some labor for the

project if and when a city NYC program is begun.
