

Army Assures Enlistees Return to 49th State

Young men who enlist in the Army for the first time from the State of Alaska can now be guaranteed return assignment to Alaska, thanks to a recent decision by the Department of the Army.

Under the new system, Alaskan youths who desire to return to Alaska need only to contact the Army recruiter at the federal building, Fairbanks, pass the Army entrance requirements, state their desire to return to Alaska for assignment, and be on their way.

Enlistees so inclined will be sent to the continental United States for basic training, and will, after completion of required training, be returned to Alaska for initial assignment.
