SEALED BIDS in duplicate, subject to the conditions within the contract documents, will be received in the office of the Commissioner, Department of Public Works, Juneau, Alaska, until 10:00 a.m., PST, May 27, 1965, at which time and place they will be publicly opened, for furnishing all labor and materials and performing all work for construction of additions to the Dillingham Airport, Dillingham, Alaska.

Plans, specifications, and project documents may be reviewed at the Alaska Department of Public Works, Juneau; the Division of Aviation, 523 Eighth Avenue, Anchorage; and at the Associated General Contractors offices in Anchorage, Fairbanks, and Seattle.

The project will include Landing Strip Extension, Taxiway, Parking Apron, Access Road, Lighting System, Maintenance Building, Road Relocation, and Drainage.

The estimated quantities of construction items to be accomplished include 3 acres of clearing; 72,000 c.y. stripping; 99,500 c.y. Class I Embankment; 135,000 c.y. Class II Embankment; 15,100 c.y. special ditch excavation; 238 l.f. C.M.P. culverts; a complete lighting system, and a 40' x 60' maintenance building.

Guarantee will be required with each bid in an amount not less than ten percent of the total bid in accordance with the INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS.
