NOTICE Wiche Graduate Fellows Program

Information brochures and applications for authorization to participate in the WICHE Graduate Fellows Program are now available from the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education, Pouch F, Juneau, Alaska 99811.

The Fellows Program provides opportunities for Alaska residents to enroll at resident tuition rates in selected graduate programs made available by other Western states cooperating in the program (Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, New Mexico and Wyoming). Alaska, in turn, makes some of its graduate programs such as Fisheries and Mining Engineering available to residents of the above states.

Eligible graduate degree programs and the institutions at which they are offered can be found in the Fellows brochure available from the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education. Students should contact the WICHE Coordinator at the Commission office for authorization to participate in the Fellows Program at the time of application to graduate school. Eligibility for authorization is based on two continuous years of Alaska residency. Authorization does not guarantee admission to a graduate program, but if admitted, the student is charged the instate tuition rate of the cooperating institution.
