

Mallot joins White House Fellow panel

Byron Mallott, chairman of the Sealaska Regional Corp., has been named a member of the northwestern regional panel for the selection of 1982-83 White House fellowships.

Mallott is the only Alaskan on the 10-member northwestern fellowship panel. There are 11 panels nationwide.

He was appointed by Admiral James Stockdale, chairman of the commission on

fellowships.

During one-year service periods the White House Fellows serve as special assistants to Administration Cabinet officers, to heads of major federal agencies and to other top federal officials.

The fellowship selection is presided over by former Washington State Gov. Dixie Lee Ray.
