

Bulk fuel handling seminars

Seminars in the management of bulk fuel will be presented in Bethel on March 30 and 31 at the Kuskokwim Community College; in Nome on April 6 and 7 at the City Council Chambers; and Fairbanks on April 13 and April 14 at the Governor's Office Conference. The two-day training sessions are specifically for representatives from communities with only seasonal surface transportation which have received grants for bulk fuel facilities from the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs. Other individuals who are involved in the ordering, receiving, storing or dispensing of petroleum fuels where fuel is only delivered seasonally are

welcome to attend and reservations are suggested.

The seminars — which begin day at 9 a.m. — will be conducted by the Alaska Division of Energy and Power Development in cooperation with the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs, Chevron U.S.A. and other State and federal agencies will also be participating.
