Do you have over 1,000 hours of military flight time; Have you served on active duty as a commissioned officer (pay grade 0-2 or ligher) in a U.S. military service in the capacity of an aviator/pilot for a minimum of two years?

Have you had military or civilian helicopter or multi-engine pilot experience within the last

two years?
