

UAF deadline is Aug. 28

Students planning to attend the University of Alaska, Fairbanks have until Aug. 28 to apply.

Director of Admissions and Records Ann Tremarello said late applicants are required to present the necessary credentials for admission. Those credentials are 2.0 grade average, high school and/or college transcripts. Required application materials must be in the Admissions Office by Aug. 28.

Late applicants are expected to keep in touch with the Admissions Office. Those who are not eligible for enrollment will be advised. Graduate stu-

dents will be accepted without class standing, and transcripts from transfer students will be evaluated after the registration process.

Late applicants (anyone applying after Aug. 12) are expected to keep in contact with the office. In-eligible applicants will be notified.

Graduate students will be accepted without class standing, and transcripts from transfer students will be evaluated after the registration process.

For students who have their paperwork applications filed, registration will be Sept. 1 - 2.
