Newsweek: This Is the Year Of the Indian

In their Jan. 15 edition, Newsweek magazine reviewed five books relating to the Indian past and made the following observations on Indians in the new year:

"In the arena of minority politics, 1973 seems a shoo-in as the Year of the Indian. As the general forkedness of the white man's tongue is further revealed by the 'broken treaties' papers, war whoops will doubtless ring through congressional halls and at radical-chic parties awash with guilt and firewater.

"The resurgence of interest in and sympathy for the red man is conspicuously reflected in books these days, and while many of them seem more concerned with white deviltry than red nobility, (some present) a string that strikes a balance."
