

Regent Fred Bigjim Elected At Haskell

Fred Bigjim, Haskell Indian Junior College Board of Regents Representative from Alaska, was recently elected as Secretary-Treasurer of the Board during their January meeting at Lawrence, Kansas.

Haskell Indian Junior College is an educational institution for American Indians. Enrollment is between 1150 and 1200 young men and women from a variety of Indian tribes throughout the nation. Haskell offers a degree in Associate of Arts and students can pursue a trade or technical skill.

The Board of Regents is made up of 15 members from geographic administrative areas of the Bureau of Indian Affairs and from other Indian communities.

Bigjim, an Eskimo from Nome, Alaska has served on the board for the past three years. He is currently studying for his Masters degree in Education at Harvard University.

In the past Mr. Bigjim was employed by Alaska Federation of Natives, Inc. as a director of one of their programs.
