

RIISING POSTAL RATES INCREASES T. T. OVERHEAD

The cost of mailing a letter went up from 20 cents to 22 cents on February 17 and nearly every other class of mail increased to an overall nine percent, which is causing some discomfort in this office.

The Tundra Times, since its first publication date in 1962, has depended to a large degree, on the U.S. Mail for distribution of our newspaper.

We have not increased the cost of our newspaper in the past eight years and hope we won't have to do so, however, if we are not successful in finding ways to make up the difference in our overall operational costs, we may have to begin charging more for our yearly subscriptions.
