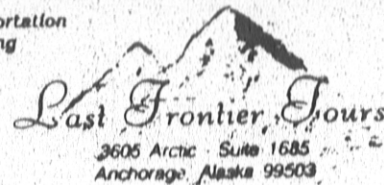

Specifically, Office of Public Advocacy desires to contract for "... cases involving indigent persons who are entitled to representation under AS 18.85.100 and who cannot be represented by the Public Defender Agency because of conflict of interest." AS 44.21.410(a)(5).
