

Prepare a report on the evaluation, including recommendations of upwardly-compatible hardware and software systems appropriate to Cook inlet Housing Authority.

Conduct a one-day workshop upon completion of the study, in Anchorage, for CIHA member representatives and HUD staff.

- (2) Evidence of structure, management, and financing affecting the Indian character of the enterprise, including major subcontracts and purchase agreements; material or supply arrangements; management, salary or profit-sharing arrangements; and evidence showing the effect of these on the extent of Indian ownership and
- (3) Evidence sufficient to demonstrate to the satisfaction of CIHA and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD, the funding agency) that the respective contractor has the technical, administrative, and financial capability to perform contract work of the scope and depth involved an within the time provided under the proposed contract.
