Next Monday is the deadline for around 3500 Sealaska "Landless" Shareholders to enrolled to the historical village sites of Ketchikan, Tenakee Springs, Wrangell, Petersburg and Haines to return their responses to the Southeast Alaska Acquisition Coalition, Inc. (SAALAC.)

These are currently "at-large" shareholders who are enrolled to the 5 villages which did not receive land allotments under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act.
