The National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism has recently been established as authorized under Public Law 91-616 of 1970.

This new institute will develop and conduct comprehensive programs of research training, development of community services, and public education for the prevention and treatment of alcohol abuse and alcoholism.

Public and private non-profit organizations and institutions may apply for grants which will establish programs in education of alcohol abuse.

Peter Kunnuk, Coordinator of Special Projects, RurAL CAP has been selected to be seated on the National Review Board which consists of 12 members.

Their purpose will be to review Indian Alcohol proposals and grants for implementation

of alcohol programs in different areas of the "lower 48" and Alaska.
