

Walsh & Co. Awarded \$3.64 Million to Build Bethel High School

The office of Governor Keith H. Miller announced that Walsh and Company, Inc., of Anchorage has been awarded a \$3.64 million contract to build the new regional high school at Bethel.

Work on the school is scheduled to start soon with completion scheduled for July 6, 1972.

The five basic units of the

school will have a total of 77,600 square feet floor space.

The school will be built around an instructional materials

center with a gymnasium unit, a science unit, and a vocational education unit radiating from this hub.

The vocational education unit will include fisheries, engine, woodworking and electronics laboratories.

The fifth unit consists of a utility section and a dormitory which is being built by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
