

IBC finds new home

After more than a year of planning and negotiating, two national Native programs operated since their inception by the Alaska Public Radio Network were transferred to Koahnic Broadcast Corporation, an Alaska Native organization, in a signing ceremony July 26. As a result of this transfer agreement, "National Native News," the country's only daily Native news program, and the In-

digenuous Broadcast Center, a national training center for Native Americans in the broadcast industry, became part of an expanding family of Native-run, Native-owned broadcast services.

Susan Braine, recently hired as president and chief executive officer of Koahnic Broadcast Corporation, sees the transfers as the fulfillment of a long-term goal for Alaska Natives in broadcasting.
