

Tanana Chiefs Executive Board to Meet at Nuchulawoya Celebration

John C. Sackett, President of the Tanana Chiefs Conference, has called for an Executive Board meeting of the Tanana Chiefs to be held at Tanana in conjunction with the Nucholowya celebration. The meetings will be held on June 8, 9, and 10.

Nucholowya is the annual interior celebration of potlatches, dances, and games of endurance and skill.

Alaska Native Foundation, formerly Alaska Federation of Natives Charitable Trust, will be attending the meetings and will be presenting a program of experts in land selection.

They will also give an in-depth review of economic development, planning, and incorporation of regional and village corporations.

The Executive Board will also discuss the housing program for interior Alaska, public health, regional boundaries, and developments on the state and federal level since the last meeting.

Morris Thompson, Area Director of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and Emil Notti, Deputy Commissioner of the Health and Social Services, will also be attending.
